January 2012, Aiden Goodwin was 11 years old, he was a happy and caring boy, who loved playing football for his school and Sunday League Teams, as well listening to his favourite music with friends.

Tragically it was at this time that Aiden was diagnosed with a rare aggressive tumour on his left kidney.

Nothing could have prepared the family for this devastating news, and the huge impact it would have on them all.

Aiden endured 2 years of chemotherapy and drug trials, never complaining once, and always had a smile for everyone.

Sadly, the tumour spread to his liver, spine and pelvis. Aiden finally lost his battle against this terrible disease in November 2013,

The family are so proud of their son and felt that they wanted to carry Aiden's name forward in some way, as well as helping other families going through a similar trauma, therefore

The Aiden Goodwin Foundation was created.



The Foundation

The Aiden Goodwin Foundation is a registered children's charity and is completely non-profit making, our team are all voluntary with one aim, to be able to bring a little happiness to children with cancer and their families.

The Foundation has worked extremely hard and has purchased our first new, eight berth Willerby Salsa Eco caravan at Combe Haven Holiday Park, Hastings.



Families are able to use our caravan at a time that is convenient for them, and are referred to us via the Demelza Hospice, CLIC Sargent, Ellenor Lions Hospice and the Royal Marsden Hospital.

The Foundation needs to continue to raise funds in order to maintain our existing caravan and to achieve our goal of purchasing a second caravan. We have various fund raising events planned throughout the year, to help make our vision a reality.



The Caravan



The Combe Haven Holiday Park is in St Leonards on Sea, Hastings, Sussex. It has fantastic facilities for all of the family, from water based activities, mini archery, football and fencing, 9-hole pitch and putt course and bike hire, as well as an indoor soft play area and adventure playground.

On the park there is a shop, food and drink services and restaurants, and day and evening entertainment programmes.

The caravan is fully equipped with all essentials required, and well stocked with games and dvd's should the family prefer to spend the day relaxing.
